Attorney General Bruning Recognizes 28th Annual National Night Out

LINCOLN - Attorney General Jon Bruning today announced his office will join communities across the state to recognize the 28th annual "National Night Out" celebration on August 2, 2011.

"This is an opportunity for neighbors to come together and recognize the good work of local law enforcement while learning how to protect themselves against potential threats," said Bruning. "Nebraskans understand a strong community is a powerful deterrent for crime."

National Night Out is a nationwide community building event designed to heighten crime prevention awareness, recognize local law enforcement agencies and generate support and participation in anti-crime programs. Across the nation, more than 15,000 communities are expected to take part in the event.

Nebraska cities will recognize National Night Out throughout the week ending August 8, 2011. Activities such as community walks, document shredding stations and safety fairs are planned.

The Attorney General's Office has partnered with members of law enforcement and community organizers in Aurora, Bellevue, Holdrege, North Platte, Papillion, Ralston and Scottsbluff. Educational resources on Internet safety, identity theft protection and consumer protection awareness will be provided to partnering communities.
