Attorney General's Office Opens Investigation of York County Attorney Bill Sutter

LINCOLN - Attorney General Jon Bruning today announced an investigation into allegations surrounding York County Attorney Bill Sutter. In a letter to York County Commissioners released yesterday, employees of the York County Attorney's Office voiced multiple concerns regarding Sutter's behavior and job performance.

"These allegations are disturbing at best and warrant further investigation," said Bruning. "Elected officials do not get a free pass in Nebraska."

Among the employees' allegations are reports of Sutter failing to perform required job duties, behaving abusively toward staff and refusing to prosecute sex offenders. In addition, the employees detailed possible misuse of evidence.
