Dear Mr. Peters:

This letter is in response to your most recent correspondence dated June 22, 2010, in which you requested our assistance in obtaining "a certified file-stamped copy of each 'Motion to Obtain Records' and 'Motion to Expunge Record'" from the Deuel County District Court. We initially construed your letter to be a petition for public records under Neb. Rev. Stat. § 84-712.03 of the Nebraska Public Records Statutes, Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 84-712 through 84-712.09 (2008; Supp. 2009). As such, we set out to determine whether you had been unlawfully denied access to public records by the district court.

We subsequently contacted the clerks for each of the district courts referenced in your letter—Deuel County and Keith County. The District Court Clerk of Deuel indicated that she had records in her possession relating to your request. We asked her to copy those records and send them to us. We have attached those records for your files. The Clerk-Magistrate for Keith County District Court represented to us that the district court had no records from or pertaining to you.

However, upon review of the various records, it appears to us that you were merely seeking acknowledgement from the Deuel County District Court as to whether your motions had been filed with the court. We have conferred with the Deuel County Attorney on this matter, who indicated that your motions would be filed. We would suggest then that all future correspondence concerning your pending motions be made to the following county official:
