Lincoln--On Thursday, October 27, 2016 Nebraska Attorney General Doug Peterson will be hosting **Mobile Office** hours in Norfolk, Nebraska at the Senior Citizens Center (307 Prospect Avenue in the Fireplace Room) from 9:30 am to 4:00 pm and will be joined by several of his staff.

After opening **Mobile Office**, General Peterson will be speaking at the Salvation Army Luncheon and talking to students at Lutheran High Northeast. He will then be back to close **Mobile Office**.
