RE: Proposed Douglas County Board of Health Directed Health Measure
for City of Omaha mask mandate

Dear Dr. Huse:

The Nebraska Attorney General has learned of your intention to issue a Directed Health Measure (DHM) implementing a city-wide mask mandate for the City of Omaha effective at midnight on Wednesday, January 12, 2022. You have not been granted approval by the Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) to issue such a mask mandate DHM.

As you are aware, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 71-1631(10), you do not have authority to unilaterally issue such a mandate without first obtaining the approval of DHHS. You previously requested DHHS approval for a similar mask mandate DHM on August 24, 2021, which DHHS denied. At that time, you were informed that should the Douglas County Board of Health attempt to enforce a DHM without state approval, the Attorney General may challenge that action.

If the Douglas County Board of Health proceeds with its intention to issue a mask mandate DHM for the City of Omaha, the Attorney General currently plans to file suit seeking to have the DHM declared invalid and to enjoin the mask mandate from being enforced.
